


HOSPITAL PROVIDER TAX PROGRAM BEGINS

Since 2003, hospitals have **paid \$7 billion in provider taxes** – nearly **\$2.1 billion of which was retained by the state** to benefit the healthcare needs of Michigan residents.

FUNDING FOR MICHIGAN'S HOSPITAL MEDICAID PROGRAM





Michigan's federally facilitated health insurance exchange begins coverage. **346,000+ people in Michigan** benefit from coverage options on the exchange, including those qualifying for federal subsidies.




More than **600,000 men and women** currently benefit from the **Healthy Michigan Plan**, which was launched in April 2014 as Michigan's Medicaid expansion program.
